## SHALOM

This Hebrew word for peace is very widely used in the Bible. It was an ordinary greeting then and even now in Israel, but it was much more than that. It conveys a sense of completeness, a state of perfect well-being, perfect communion with God. So it's much richer than our English word 'peace'.

During the Last Supper Jesus said to the apostles 'Peace I leave with you, my *own* peace I give you.' After his resurrection he greeted them with the words 'Peace be with you.' By these words he turned their despair into hope, and their sadness into joy.

Sadly, during my visit to the Holy Land it was evident that there is still need for peace and good will there. While we were in no danger, the Christians are having to live almost a life of oppression. Their economic situation is much worse than the Israelis. their education is excellent but jobs are not available. We were privileged to visit a Day Care Centre, a children's hospital and an orphanage, all dependent on donations. We had Mass in Bethlehem with the local community last Sunday. Please

keep them in your prayers. Of course were privileged to visit all the Holy Sites too, where I remembered you all in prayer. You can follow our diary (up to the last few days) and see photos on the diocesan website.

May we all be blessed with the gift of peace.
