

# **WARNING!**

To all families looking to educate their children in a Catholic School. The Supplementary Information Form is to be abolished, which allowed Parish Priests to indicate to schools if a family attended Mass but on an infrequent basis, say fortnightly, Monthly or on occasion. A certificate stating:

I hereby certify that this child and his/her family are known to me and, to the best of my knowledge and belief, the child is from a practising Catholic family.

which we sign or don't sign, is all that will be available to Parish Priests moving

We have recently received instruction about what definition is to be given to the statement, i.e. what is a practicing Catholic family, and it states:

for the purposes of the Certificate of Catholic Practice, a person is a practising Catholic if they observe the Church's precept of attending Mass on Sundays and holidays of obligation.

This definition is taken from the Catechism of the Catholic Church so should not be a surprise to any of us.

If you know you are not regular on a Sunday, you need to start making more of an effort now. If when the time comes for you to make your application and you are still not attending on a Sunday, do not approach your priest for a certificate with the expectation that he will lie for you. You can still make an application to a Catholic School without the certificate as long as you have proof of Baptism, & if the school is under subscribed you are likely to get a place. Some schools have been through the consultation process & others will be implementing this change in 2025. PUT THE MESSAGE AROUND, ESPECIALLY TO THOSE FRIENDS OF

YOURS WHO YOU HAVE NOT SEEN AT MASS FOR A WHILE.
