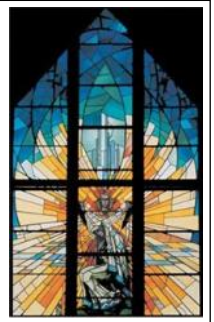

30th June Saints Peter & Paul Sunday (page 172 of Parish Mass Book) YEAR B

These two Saints stand before us today to witness their love for someone. Both Peter and Paul had their moments of weakness. They both were called by Christ regardless of their failings. The Lord shows us through them the power of His love. He leads them both to glory through death.

Both Apostles are martyrs, but of what? *Therefore I tell you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she loved much; but he who is forgiven little, loves little* (Lk 7.47). They are martyrs of great love - Love with a capital 'L'. They had experienced their own vulnerability and were loved. They felt that love, and that love transformed them.
